RESOLUTION AMENDING THE MENDOTA CITY ORDINANCE TO  
AMEND CHAPTER 805 REGULATING PARKING AND TOWING

WHEREAS, the City of Mendota desires to update and amend the City Code of Ordinances regarding certain requirements related to parking within the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MENDOTA, DAKOTA COUNTY, MINNESOTA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to remove and replace the current Section 805.0254 with the following language:

805.245 – Snow Parking – Except when otherwise posted, marked or metered, no vehicle shall be parked or stand on the street or alleys in the City for more than thirty (30) minutes during the time intervening between a snowfall of two inches (2”) or more and the plowing or removal thereof.

2. The City Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to remove and replace the current Section 805.0255 with the following language:

805.0255 – Vehicle Towing – The police department, fire department, and all members thereof, may authorize the towing of a vehicle within the City under the authority of Minn. Stat. § 168B.035, including for violations arising from parking, registration and snow emergency. The Departments shall set their own policies regarding its towing procedures in accordance with the authority granted under Minnesota Statute.
